As many of you know, the Rules Board this season have decided that it is better that umpires are more confused than the players and have issued two statements to confirm their decision.

On the 25th September a press release was issued to tell umpires that any penalty corner taken from more than 5 yards outside the circle, must be stopped inside or outside the circle before a hit at goal is made.

Within two weeks, AEWHA sent out another letter which tried to tell umpires to ignore the press release of 25th September, but was so badly worded that many people thought that the mandatory experimental rule had been changed as well!

Where are we now?

We are playing the mandatory experimental rule which asks for the ball to be stopped outside the circle before a shot at goal is made.

Any short corner taken from beyond 5 yards outside the circle is considered not to come under these rules.

ACWHUA have arranged another Open Evening at Clifton College Pavilion on **NOVEMBER 26TH at 8.00PM** to discuss problems arising from this rule, and of course, any other interesting items which need an airing.

We are also endeavouring to get hold of a new video made by FIH on umpiring. If anyone can help us with a video recorder and TV please ring Pete Lovell.

QUIZ

- 1. Substitutions may be made
 - a. At any time

2. The goalkeeper
